Weltix S.p.A. Information Notice on the Processing of Personal Data Website Navigation Privacy Policy

Weltix S.p.A. (hereinafter also referred to as the "Data Controller") provides the Data Subject or User—namely, the individual to whom the personal data refers—with the following information pursuant to Article 13 of the European General Data Protection Regulation (EU Regulation No. 2016/679, hereinafter referred to as the "GDPR"). This information notice aims to describe the characteristics of the processing operations carried out concerning the personal data provided by the Data Subject, as well as the technical and organizational measures adopted to safeguard and protect their rights.

1. Processed Data, Purposes, Retention Period, and Legal Basis

2. Methods of Personal Data Processing

Personal data are processed exclusively for the achievement of the Purposes outlined in this privacy policy, leveraging automated and electronic tools on digital supports.

3. Nature of Data Provision: Mandatory vs. Optional

The provision of personal data required to pursue the specified Purposes is strictly categorized as follows:

- Purposes under letters (a), (d), and (e): The provision of data is **mandatory**. A refusal to supply these details will render it impossible for the Data Subject to browse the Website and benefit from the services offered by the Platform.
- Purposes under letters (b) and (c): The provision of data is **optional**. Consequently, refusal to provide these details will merely prevent the Data Subject from receiving responses to their

requests.

4. Categories of Subjects Authorized to Receive Communication

Personal data processing may be performed, within the scope of strict necessity and absolute proportionality, by internal staff and external professionals:

Internal to Weltix

Data will be handled by designated internal personnel formally authorized for processing operations (pursuant to Article 29 of the GDPR and Article 2-quaterdecies of Italian Legislative Decree no. 101/2018) within the following divisions:

- Administrative Department
- Marketing and Customer Service Departments

External to Weltix

Data may be handled by third parties categorized under the following macro-categories:

- **Service Providers:** Specialized external entities that the Data Controller contracts for instrumental and ancillary operations necessary to achieve the specified Purposes (e.g., software vendors, cloud computing partners, datacenters, and professional consultants). These entities are formally designated as **External Data Processors** pursuant to Article 28 of the GDPR, establishing stringent contractual and regulatory constraints ensuring total confidentiality and compliance. They possess access uniquely to data elements essential for their specified tasks. A complete list of these External Data Processors is available upon explicit request of the Data Subject.
- **Independent Data Controllers (Third Parties):** Entities whose right of access to the Data Subject's personal data is directly established by provisions of European Union law or Italian national legislation (e.g., competent authorities for compliance with statutory rules, or public administrative bodies for their institutional goals).

5. Dissemination of Personal Data

Under no circumstances or conditions will personal data be subject to general public dissemination.

6. Statutory Rights of the Data Subject

Pursuant to the official provisions of the GDPR, the Data Subject is fully entitled to exercise the following core rights directly against the Data Controller:



GDPR Standard Right	Legal Description & Scope
Right of Access	The right to obtain a copy of the personal data concerning them that are being processed by the Data Controller.
Right to Rectification	The right to obtain the rectification of personal data stored by the Controller if they are not updated or correct.
Right to Object for Commercial Purposes	The right to request that the Data Controller ceases to send commercial communications at any time.
Right to Object to Automated Decisions	The right to request not to be the recipient of decisions based solely on automated processing, including profiling activities.
Right to Withdraw Consent	The right to withdraw previously granted consent for a specific processing operation at any given time.
Right to Lodge a Complaint	The right to contact the competent supervisory authority (Garante per la protezione dei dati personali) if they have doubts about the processing of personal data carried out by the Data Controller.

Additionally, upon the occurrence of specific legal thresholds or criteria, the Data Subject can leverage the following complementary rights:

Conditional GDPR Right	Legal Description & Scope
Right to Erasure ('Right to be Forgotten')	The right to request that the Data Controller deletes the Data Subject's personal data when the purposes of the processing have ceased, and there are no legitimate interests or legal norms requiring their continuation.
Right to Object to a	The right to request that the Data Controller ceases to carry out



Conditional GDPR Right	Legal Description & Scope
Processing	a specific processing operation on the Data Subject's personal data.
Right to Restrict Processing	The right to request that the Data Controller limits the processing operations on the Data Subject's personal data.
Right to Data Portability	The right to obtain a copy of the data in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format from another Data Controller.

7. Formal Procedures for Exercising Rights
